



THE IMPORTANCE OF HOME-WORKING IN INCREASING POPULATION INCOME

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Abstract: The purpose of the article is to reveal the importance of home-based farming in increasing the income of the population. Comments are given on its legal basis. The need for the development of cottage industries in Uzbekistan is noted.

Key words: cottage industry, small business, entrepreneurship, family enterprises, household income.

A number of legal documents passed in recent years in our country are aimed at improving the economic and social life of the population, and are focused on the development of the household, which is a source of family income. With the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated January 5, 2006 "On measures to encourage the expansion of cooperation between large industrial enterprises and production and services based on the development of home economics" a wide path was opened to home economics in our country.

On January 11, 2006, Cabinet of Ministers Resolution No. 4 was adopted in order to ensure the implementation of this Decree. According to it, the "Regulation on Housekeeping" and the model labor contract for the execution of works (rendering of services) by the housekeeper on the order of the employer were approved.

On April 6, 2007, the Decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. 616 "On measures to increase the employment of the population and improve the activities of the labor and social protection bodies" was adopted as a logical continuation of the ongoing work. This decision envisages the introduction of domestic labor in other sectors of the economy, first of all, in large enterprises of the transport, communication, construction and construction industry, as well as in small industrial enterprises specializing in the production of products.

Another important document in the development of homesteading was the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers dated July 1, 2008 No. 146 "On measures to improve the organization of homesteading and to increase the responsibility of the heads of local state authorities and economic management bodies for the fulfillment of the parameters of its development."

Based on the Decision No. 1112 of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated May 15, 2009 "On measures to further support and develop entrepreneurial activity", a number of benefits were granted to business entities. With this decision, it was determined that when a small enterprise

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concludes labor contracts with citizens working at their homes (doing household chores) in the amount exceeding the limited number of employees specified by law by no more than 30 percent, the guarantees, benefits and preferences provided for small enterprises will be preserved for this enterprise.

President I.Karimov's speech at the joint meeting of the Legislative Chamber and the Senate of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan on November 12, 2010 entitled "The concept of further deepening democratic reforms and development of civil society in our country" paid special attention to the further deepening of democratic market reforms and economic liberalization, among other important priority issues. and small business, promotion of private entrepreneurship activities, determination of tasks related to legal protection are also important in the further development of home economics.

The year of "Attention to people and quality education" continues. This year, the adoption of a number of new laws on the development of small business and private entrepreneurship, family entrepreneurship and home economics will open the door to new opportunities for those engaged in entrepreneurial activities, including homemakers who produce export products that serve to develop the economy of our country. This plays an important role in the creation of new jobs, the professional and employment of young people, and the provision of social protection of the population.

The Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on January 5, 2006 "On measures to encourage the expansion of cooperation between production and services based on the development of the household industry" adopted on January 5, 2006 in order to fully utilize the existing opportunities of the household industry to increase employment and income specified:

- exemption of enterprises organizing household activities from paying a single social payment from the wage fund for a period of five years, in the amount equal to the funds paid to householders;
- giving the employer the right to provide tools, equipment and inventory to householders for free or on lease, including on the basis of leasing (financial lease);
- exemption from property tax during the period of use of tools, equipment and inventory given to homeowners for free use to perform work on the order of the enterprise, etc.

Efforts to turn neighborhoods into centers of private entrepreneurship and family businesses are paying off.

The well-being of the population depends, on the one hand, on the neighborhood entrepreneurs, businessmen, tailors, skilled artisans, and diligent farmers. Entrepreneurs who start their own small business activities in the neighborhoods make a decent contribution to providing employment to their fellow residents, and to attract housewives to useful work through the development of the household economy.

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
